

### ADJUSTABLE HAND PUNCH

The Sieber Products Manufacturing Company, 4000-4006 Laclede Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri, has placed on the market a device known as the Sieber Adjustable Hand Punch.

This punch is said to be well constructed and is built to take all



classes of loose leaf punching,

taking any size sheet. The dies are easy to adjust to various centers up to  $8\frac{1}{2}$  inches center to center. The movable end gauge may be locked at any place, and the table is graduated to give center to center of holes with greatest ease.

Punch movement is positive with eccentric shaft giving extra power to stroke. Dies are made of hardened steel self sharpening, nickel plated. The punch is copper oxidized with nickel plated table and handle grip. Solid round holes from  $\frac{1}{8}$  to  $\frac{5}{8}$  inches in diameter can be punched with this hand machine.

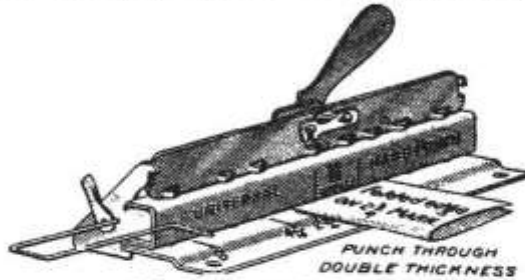

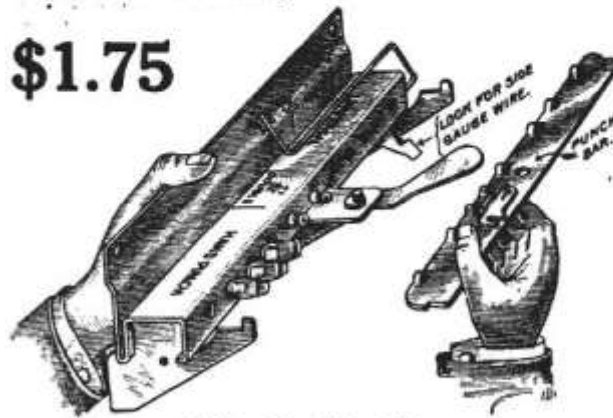

## Southworth Punching Machine.

We show herewith an illustration of the Southworth punching machine made by Southworth Brothers Company, Portland, Me. It contains some features that will recommend it to those houses that have use for a machine that will not only do the finest quality of punching, but quantity as well. Anything from a single sheet up to the full capacity, one-half inch of stock, can be punched. It is a very powerful hand punch and we understand the power is multiplied twenty times, that is, a fifty pound pressure on the handle will equal one thousand pounds on the punch. One of the features is the fact that the punch and die can be changed from one



size to another in less than a minute without the use of any tools. Another feature is the perfect set of gauges this machine has. The back gauge is easily moved so that a hole can be punched close to the edge of a sheet of stock or any distance from the margin up to four inches. The side gauges can be adjusted to the hundredth part of an inch. After the gauges are once set they cannot possibly slip.

Another exclusive feature is the stripper, thru which the punch passes. It supports the punch rigidly, insuring absolute alignment and prevents wear to the punch and die. The stripper is made with a spiral groove, and by simply revolving, it can be raised or lowered to accommodate the various thicknesses of stock to be punched.

The price of the machine is only \$15, including one punch. Extra punches are \$2 per set, the set consisting of punch, die and stripper.
